The Earthquake Commission (EQC) is New Zealand's primary provider of natural disaster insurance for owners of residential property. As part of the Commission's insurance programme, it also provides training on EQCover and conducts spot checks of insurance companies and brokers to ensure EQC receives the correct premiums.
